- 1 The Mount Pleasant** (The Stump) 144 High Street (independent)
Offering a choice of up to 10 real ales.
Number 1 bus stops nearby
- 2 The Beacon Hotel** 129 Bilston Street (independent)
In 2025 Good Beer Guide and home of Sarah Hughes Brewery - two guest real ales and three Sarah Hughes beers, usually Dark Ruby Mild, Surprise and Amber
- 3 The White Lion** 103 Bilston Street (independent)
In 2025 Good Beer Guide offering four real ales
- 4 The Bull's Head** 27 Bilston Street (Holden's)
Selection of Holden's real ales. Rear of pub is Ann's Thai restaurant open from 5pm other than Sundays
- 5 The Clifton** Bull Ring (JD Wetherspoon)
Offering all day food and changing selection of real ales
- 6 The Swan Inn** 1 Gospel End Street (RoJo Pub Company)
Offering up to five real ales
- 7 Sandy's** 49 Dudley Road
Cafe opening as micropub with three real ales on Fridays and Saturdays from 5pm to 10pm
- 8 Seven Stars** 61 Gospel End Street (Marston's)
Pub offering food all day - one real ale.
- 9 Crown** High Street (independent)
Desi pub serving Indian food, two real ales available

Upper Gornal:

The Jolly Crispin Clarence Street (RoJo Pub Company)

The Britannia Kent Street (Batham's)

Both on Number 1 bus route from Market Hall, Dudley Street

Lower Gornal:

The Chapel House Ruiton Street (Holden's)

The Fountain Temple Street (independent)

The Old Bull's Head Redhall Street (Black Country Ales)

Home of BCA's brewery at rear. On 27 and 27A bus route from Market Hall

Woodsetton:

The Park Inn George Street (Holden's)

Next door to the brewery

On 229 bus route from Market Hall

The historic village of Sedgley - mentioned in the Domesday Book - has many pubs offering real ale.

It has one brewery - Sarah Hughes - at the Beacon Hotel producing award-winning Dark Ruby Mild and Sedgley Surprise.

Nearby Woodsetton is home to Holden's Brewery.
