 John Rolinson & Son Ltd was a brewery in Netherton, acquired by W&D in 1912.
- 19 DWAF 1995 Jeff Astle Collection. Glass, bottle and flyer. Condition good.
- The Batham's 9 Poster. A graphical map of 9 Batham's pubs: Britannia (Sallies), Lamp, Holly Bush, Vine (Bull & Bladder), Plough & Harrow, Unicorn, Royal Exchange, Plough, Swan. (Dating from the mid 1990s.)
- 21-24 Beer Bears by Dee. Made with recycled beer festival staff polo shirts, incorporating various embroidered elements. The stuffing is new and complies with safety standards. Eyes are buttons, so would need to be changed if for a child. These bears are individual and quirky.
 - Yellow and red bear with CAMRA logos and Dudley & South Staffs.
 - Black and turquoise bear with Holden's centenary logo and Holden's feet.
